

CURRICULUM COUNCIL, CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

- (1) Will the minister inform the house - I presume she knows - of the salary being paid to Norma Jeffery, the chief executive officer of the Curriculum Council?
- (2) What is her role and function, now that she is not in that position?
- (3) Will she receive the same salary?
- (4) What position did she leave to take up the position of chief executive officer at the Curriculum Council?
