

SALE OF GOVERNMENT-OWNED ASSETS

1856. Mr T.R. Buswell to the Attorney General; Health; Electoral Affairs

Will the Attorney General provide the following details for all Government-owned assets sold since 1 January 2003 which had a sale value of \$500,000 or more -

- (a) name and nature of the asset;
- (b) date sold;
- (c) nature of sale and name of buyer;
- (d) proceeds received from the asset;
- (e) associated revenue from the sale, such as stamp duty;
- (f) the application of the funds received; and
- (g) any associated costs incurred in the sale process?
