

JANDAKOT AIRPORT EXPANSION — MANAGEMENT PLAN

2724. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Environment

- (1) Where is the Construction Environmental Management Plan for the development at Jandakot Airport, so the public can be aware of their commitments and conditions?
- (2) How was the independent chair chosen and did it follow the guidelines?
- (3) Why are there no representatives from local environmental groups on the Community Aviation Consultation Group?

Hon DONNA FARAGHER replied:

- (1) Jandakot Airport is Commonwealth land and is therefore subject to Commonwealth environmental legislation. Approvals and conditions in relation to environmental matters are dealt with by the Commonwealth Government. - (2)-(3) It is my understanding, based on advice from the Department of Environment and Conservation, that the establishment and management of the Jandakot Airport Community Aviation Consultation Group is the responsibility of Jandakot Airport and the Commonwealth Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government. The State Government has no role in this.
