## PETROLEUM AND GEOTHERMAL ENERGY SAFETY LEVIES AMENDMENT BILL 2011

Receipt and First Reading

Bill received from the Assembly; and, on motion by Hon Norman Moore (Minister for Mines and Petroleum), read a first time.

Second Reading

**HON NORMAN MOORE (Mining and Pastoral — Minister for Mines and Petroleum)** [7.35 pm]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

The purpose of the bill is to amend the Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Safety Levies Bill 2011 in order to impose the safety levies as provided for in the Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Safety Levies Bill 2011. The bill is required to be produced as a separate amendment bill as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899, section 46(7), requires that bills imposing taxation must deal only with the imposition of taxation.
