## TRANSPERTH AND SCHOOL SPECIAL BUS SERVICE BUSES - PASSENGER NUMBERS

311. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:
(1) How many passengers can be carried on a regular Transperth bus?
(2) How many students are permitted to travel on a school special bus?

## Hon JIM CHOWN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.
(1) The maximum licensed capacity ranges from 64 to 110 passengers dependent on the type of Transperth bus being operated on a particular bus route.
(2) The maximum number of students permitted to travel on a school special bus service is also governed by the same licence capacity criteria.
