## CORRECTIVE SERVICES — YOUNG OFFENDERS — PHYSICAL RESTRAINT

## 1002. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Corrective Services:

I refer to regulation 72 of the Young Offenders Regulations, which relates to section 11C(2) of the Young Offenders Act 1994.

- (1) How many times in 2014, 2015 and 2016 to date were medical examinations conducted on detainees on whom prescribed force or other similar physical restraint had been used?
- (2) How many written reports of incidents involving the use of prescribed force or other similar physical restraint were provided to the superintendent in each of these years?
- (3) For each incident referred to in (1) and (2), in which facility did the use of force occur and what was the age of the detainee?

## Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN replied:

On behalf of the Minister for Corrective Services, I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. The Department of Corrective Services has advised that the information requested is not recorded in a manner that is easily retrievable and would require the significant manual retrieval of approximately 3 000 records.
