3191. Ms J. Farrer to the Minister representing the Education:

- (1) How many times in each of the following years has it been reported to the Department of Education that the Fitzroy Crossing School has been broken into:
 - (a) 2012;
 - (b) 2013; and
 - (c) 2014?
- (2) What has been the cost of damage to property during break-ins at the Fitzroy Crossing School for each of the following years:
 - (a) 2012;
 - (b) 2013; and
 - (c) 2014?
- (3) What has been the value of goods stolen during break-ins at the Fitzroy Crossing School for each of the following years:
 - (a) 2012;
 - (b) 2013; and
 - (c) 2014?
- (4) Does the Fitzroy Crossing School currently have security cameras?
- (5) If no to (4), when will the Department of Education fund the installation of security cameras in the Fitzroy Crossing School?

 - (c) 4
- (2)–(3) The Department of Education's central database does not provide a breakdown between the cost of damage to property and value of goods stolen during these incidents. The total cost for damage to property and loss of stolen goods is:
 - (a) \$17 467
 - (b) \$5 001
 - (c) \$114 750
- (4) Yes. Funding was approved for the installation of CCTV. The school confirmed that the installation of the CCTV was completed on 29 January 2015.
