

CYBERSECURITY — GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

**110. Hon WILSON TUCKER to the Minister for Innovation and the Digital Economy:**

I refer to the Office of Digital Government and the WA government's cybersecurity policy. Of the 66 agencies required to submit an implementation plan, how many have been assessed as compliant?

**Hon SUE ELLERY replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. I answer on behalf of the minister. The Department of the Premier and Cabinet has provided the following answer.

Assessments of agency implementation plans do not result in a compliant or noncompliant outcome. Agencies are required to continuously assess and improve their cybersecurity maturity in relation to a range of controls and governance requirements.
