

MINISTER FOR POLICE — PORTFOLIOS — STAFF — ANNUAL LEAVE

1536. Hon Tjorn Sibma to the minister representing the Minister for Police; Road Safety:

As at 30 June 2018, for each agency/department within the Minister's portfolio, can you provide in tabular form, the total dollar value of accrued annual leave balances and the number of staff to whom these balances apply, for leave balances of the following periods of time:

- (a) four to five weeks;
- (b) five to six weeks;
- (c) six to seven weeks;
- (d) seven to eight weeks; and
- (e) greater than eight weeks?

Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

The Western Australia Police Force advise the following information relates to police officers, police staff and Road Safety Commission staff, and notes that police officers receive six weeks annual leave per annum:
