278. Mr R.C. KUCERA to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

Can the minister please explain what actions the government is taking in relation to Bush Forever in the Mirrabooka-Yokine area?

Ms A.J.G. MacTIERNAN replied:

I thank the member Yokine for the question, and for all the hard work he has put into helping us advance a resolution on this site. It is with great pleasure that I advise the house that, last night, I signed off on a \$16.7 million purchase of 77 hectares of bushland from the Department of Housing and Works. The area is situated along Reid Highway, between Mirrabooka Avenue and Northwood Drive, and it has been identified by the state government as a Bush Forever site.
