

KEMERTON INDUSTRIAL PARK COORDINATING COMMITTEE, MEMBERSHIP

741. Mr GRILL to the Minister for Resources Development:

In relation to the Kemerton Industrial Park Coordinating Committee -

- (a) apart from the Harvey Shire Councillor, are any other members of the local community represented on this Committee;

- (c) will the discussions and decisions of the Committee be made available to the public, and if so, by what means?

Mr BARNETT replied:

Further, one of these councillors is a member of the Kemerton Community Committee.
