MAYLANDS BOATYARD PTY LTD, LEASE

191. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection

I refer the Minister to the lease between the Western Australian Planning Commission and the Maylands Boatyard Pty Ltd dated July 1987, and ask:

- (a) has WorkSafe carried out any inspections of the Maylands Boatyard to ascertain the safety of the boat cradle and jetties, especially the refuelling jetty;
- (b) if not, why not;
- (c) have any work orders been issued on the Maylands Boatyard;
- (d) have any follow up inspections taken place as a result of these work orders;
- (e) if not, why not;
- (f) will the Minister table all inspection reports, work orders and follow up inspection reports; and
- (g) if not, why not?

Mr J.C. KOBELKE replied:

- (a) Yes, two inspections have been carried out since December 1998.
- (b) Not applicable.
- (c) Yes, four improvement notices and one prohibition notice have been issued.
- (d) The second inspection was a follow-up to the first.
- (e) Not applicable.
