## FREMANTLE HOSPITAL, AIRCONDITIONING

## 1294. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Health

I refer the Minister to recent upgrading of the air conditioning at Fremantle Hospital and ask -

- (a) what manufacturers' brands and types of flexible air conditioning duct were installed in the Fremantle Hospital Emergency Wing;
- (b) did all of these brands and types of products comply with CAMS and/or all other required specifications;
- (c) what documentation was submitted to substantiate compliance with these specifications;
- (d) will the Minister provide copies of this documentation;
- (e) was this installation inspected by Government representatives, to ensure the correct products were installed;
- (f) who carried out this inspection and what are the qualifications of these inspectors;
- (g) what were the dates of these inspections; and
- (h) at what stage of the installation were these inspections carried out?

## Mr KUCERA replied:

(a)-(h) Fremantle Hospital has not had any recent major upgrading of the air conditioning in its Emergency Department.
