- (1) How many, and what type of security incidents have occurred at the Edgewater train station, the Joondalup train station, the Currambine train station and the Whitfords train station, how many of those incidents:
 - (a) were referred to the Police for investigation at each station;
 - (b) resulted in property damage or theft at each station; and
 - (c) at each station required medical or other assistance at each station?

Mr T.R. BUSWELL replied:

The Public Transport Authority advises:

(1) (a)–(c) The Joondalup line and its stations opened in 1992 and accordingly it would be considered a significant burden for the agency and staff to review more than eighteen years of accumulated incident reports.
