

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, STAFF, REDEPLOYED, ON THE "ATTACHED LIST" AND DISPLACED

2515. Mrs C.L. Edwardes to the Premier

I refer the Premier to the redeployment list and ask -

- (a) how many public servants and public sector employees are currently on redeployment;
- (b) what was the previous job title, salary and date each person was sent for redeployment;
- (c) how many public servants and public sector employees are on the 'attached list' of Departments and agencies;
- (d) what was the previous job title, salary and date each person was sent to the 'attached list';
- (e) how many public servants and public sector employees are 'displaced' but not currently on the 'attached list' or on redeployment; and in which Departments and Agencies are these officers listed; and
- (f) what was the previous job title, salary and date each person was sent to displacement?

Dr G.I. GALLOP replied:

- (a) As at 9 March 2004, a total of 168 public service/public sector employees are registered for redeployment.
- (b) Information on the 168 employees' previous job title, salary range as it equates to the Public Service General Agreement 2002, and their date of redeployment registration is given in the attached schedule. [See paper No 2229.]
- (c)-(f) This information is not centrally maintained. Individual Departments and agencies are responsible for the management of employees without substantive positions, including their possible registration for redeployment.
