

WESTERN AUSTRALIAN ABORIGINAL CHILD HEALTH SURVEY

5956. Hon Shelley Archer to the Minister for Local Government representing the Minister for Indigenous Affairs

I refer the Minister to the Report on the Western Australian Aboriginal Child Health Survey, carried out by the Kulunga Research Network at the Telethon Institute for Child Health Research. I draw the Minister's attention to Recommendation 23 of the Report, namely, 'Governments should be encouraged to build OID indicators into the key performance indicators (KPIs) for departments and into the performance reporting of ICC regions and community agency funding agreements', and I ask —
