960. Hon NIGEL HALLETT to the minister representing the Minister for the Environment:

Will the minister please provide the following information -

- (1) What schemes does the state government currently provide funding to for the removal of group 2 rural chemicals?
- (2) Is the minister aware that the national initiative called Chemclear is seeking funding from the state government?
- (3) If yes to (2), why has funding not been approved to subsidise its services to collect and dispose of group 2 chemicals in Western Australia?
- (4) If the minister will not support the Chemclear initiative, will she please give details on what should be done with group 2 chemicals currently on rural properties?
- (5) Is the minister aware of how much dumping of group 2 chemicals currently takes place on Western Australian farms to avoid the high costs associated with authorised removal?
