2535. Mrs C.L. Edwardes to the Premier

I refer the Premier to the 2002/2003 Annual Report of the Department of Premier and Cabinet and ask -

- (a) what is the current status of the on-line registration and licensing system;
- (b) what was the cost of the feasibility study and who conducted the study;
- (c) will the Premier table the feasibility study and the business case referred to in the annual report for 2002/2003;
- (d) what is the cost of building the interactive front end;
- (e) who carried out the work and how much were they paid;
- (f) was the contract put out for tender;
- (g) who were the other tenders;
- (h) what is the next phase being considered;
- (i) what is the estimated cost; and
- (j) when will this phase go to tender?

Dr G.I. GALLOP replied:

- (a) This project was initiated by the Department of Industry and Technology and completed in October 2002. Due to changes arising out of the Functional Review Implementation Taskforce recommendations, the preliminary recommendation to proceed with the design and building of the web based interactive front end was not pursued. A new project definition and scope is to be developed.
- (b) \$42,900, Deakin Management Consulting on behalf of the Department of Industry and Technology.
