## DICHLORVOS, APPROVAL FOR USE

- 96. Mr J.L. Bradshaw to the Minister for Health
- (1) Is the Minister aware that the insecticide Dichlorvos has been withdrawn from use in the United Kingdom following advice from the Independent Advisory Committee on pesticides?
- (2) Why is Dichlorvos still approved to be used in Western Australia?
- (3) Does the Minister have any input into the banning of such chemicals?

## Mr R.C. KUCERA replied:

- 1. I am informed that some products containing dichlorvos registered for home use have been withdrawn in the UK as a precautionary measure.
- 2. The National Registration Authority (NRA) based in Canberra confirms that dichlorvos remains registered Australia-wide, however the pesticide is currently under review. I will wait for the completion of this review by the NRA.
- 3. Under the NRAs Existing Chemical Review Program, all stakeholders, including the West Australian Department of Health, are provided with the opportunity to provide comment on the chemical under review.
