- 108. Dr CONSTABLE to the Minister for Health:
- (1) What is the total number of patients in public hospitals currently occupying beds while they wait for beds to become available in nursing homes?
- Which hospitals have beds occupied by individuals while they wait for beds to become available in nursing homes?
- (3) How many beds in each of the above hospitals are occupied by individuals while they wait for beds to become available in nursing homes?

Mr KUCERA replied:

(1) 400 patients. In the country hospitals 162 patients of the 400 patients are classified Nursing Home Type Patients, who are permanent residents of these facilities ie. State's acute care facilities as there are no Commonwealth funded residential aged care facilities to which they can be transferred.
