I refer to the government's firearm buyback compensation scheme. What peak bodies or industry experts did the government consult to determine the appropriate buyback fee payable for the scheme?

The Western Australia Police Force advises that due to confidentiality agreements, the agency is unable to provide the requested details regarding the consultation participants. Due to confidentiality and privacy concerns, the requested details may cause commercial impact and potential risks to their businesses.
