

BETTY STREET RESERVE, CHIDLOW — CROWN LAND BUSH RESERVE

Petition

MR F.A. ALBAN (Swan Hills) [3.11 pm]: I have a petition that has been certified as conforming with the standing orders of the Assembly. It has 205 signatures. The petition says —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say that Betty Street Reserve lot 382, Betty street, Chidlow, (included in Structure Plan 69 for development), retain its current protected status as crown land bush reserve. It is rich in historical and environmental value (WW2 camp sites, Aboriginal sacred trees, habitat and feeding grounds for endangered and threatened species)

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to prevent the sale of Betty Street Reserve to any land developers and keep it in perpetuity as a Public Bush Reserve.
