

KING EDWARD MEMORIAL HOSPITAL FOR WOMEN, NEGLIGENCE CLAIMS

1577. Hon DERRICK TOMLINSON to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Health:

- (1) In the past five years how many suits for negligence have been brought against medical officers at the King Edward Memorial Hospital for Women?
- (2) In each case, who were the named defendants?
- (3) What is the total amount that has been paid to successful litigants in each of the past five years?
- (4) Who were the named defendants in those suits and what amount was awarded against each of them?
- (5) Who was the insurer in each case?
