- 6. Mr Bradshaw to the Minister for Health
- (1) How much money has been spent in the last two years, as indicated available in 2000-2001 Budget Statements in the Health Section under "Works in Progress", on the Yarloop/Harvey IHS Planning?
- (2) When will the plan be finalised?
- (3) Will this planning have to be completed before any major capital works funds are made available for the Yarloop Hospital?
- (4) Is the Minister aware of the antiquated condition of the Yarloop Hospital and when will funds be made available for a Multi Purpose Centre at Yarloop?

## Mr KUCERA replied:

- (1) \$33 000.
- (2) Planning should be finalised during 2001/02.
- (3) Yes.
- (4) The Yarloop Hospital has been regularly maintained with minor works funds being allocated in recent years for hospital and staff accommodation refurbishments, medical equipment and a new emergency generator. The Government is currently reviewing its Capital Works Program for 2001/02 and outyears and will finalise this in the coming months.
