I refer to the recently released performance inquiry report into Kalbarri District High School.

- (1) In each of the years 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011 and to date in 2012, what is the total number of formal complaints received by the midwest education regional office, the head office of the Department of Education and the Minister for Education in relation to the performance and behaviour of the school's administration staff, principal and deputy principal?
- Given that the expert review group inquired into and reported on the relations between Kalbarri District High School and the local community, by what timeframe is the school expected to develop strategies for improved community relations?
