WORKSAFE WA, ADVICE ON FUTURE OPERATION

310. Hon C L Edwardes to the Minister for Labour Relations

I refer the Minister to the Government's stated intervention to incorporate WorkSafe into the new Department of Employment and Consumer Protection, and ask -

- (a) has the Minister received advice from the independent statutory body known as the WorkSafe Western Australia Commission on the Government's proposal;
- (b) if so, was this advice in writing;
- (c) if so, will the Minister table this advice;
- (d) if not, why not; and
- (e) if the advice was verbal, who delivered this advice and will the Minister outline this advice? Mr KOBELKE replied:
 - (a) The WorkSafe Western Australia Commission made a submission to the Machinery of Government Taskforce and provided me with a copy.
 - (b) Yes
 - (c)-(d) It is not appropriate to table this submission at this time. The Machinery of Government Taskforce has received a range of submissions on this issue and it would not be prudent to assess one submission in isolation.
