

PLANNING APPEALS, NUMBER

85. Mrs Edwardes to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure
- (1) I refer the minister to Ministerial Appeals on Planning matters and ask how many appeals had been lodged for determination as at 9 February 2001?
  - (2) How many appeals had been considered by the Appeals Committee with a recommendation for the minister's consideration and decision as at 9 February 2001?
  - (3) How many appeals has the minister now made a decision on as at 30 April 2001?
  - (4) Of those decisions made, how many has the minister upheld, and how many has the minister refused?
  - (5) How many appeals have been lodged since 12 February 2001?

Ms MacTIERNAN replied:

- (1) As at 9 February 2001, a total of 351 appeals to the minister had been lodged (as at 16 February 2001, the date of swearing in of new Cabinet, there was a total of 370 appeals lodged to the Minister for Planning).
- (2) 43
- (3) 74
- (4) Of the 74 appeals determined as of 30 April 2001, the breakdown is as follows -  
27 upheld/upheld in part  
38 dismissed  
3 determined to have no right of appeal  
6 deferred for more information
- (5) 173 (from 12 February to 31 July 2001)
