## CYBER ATTACKS — DEPARTMENT OF THE PREMIER AND CABINET

Question without Notice 694 and 695 — Supplementary Information

MR D.J. KELLY (Bassendean — Minister for Innovation and ICT) [3.07 pm]: Pursuant to standing order 82A, I rise to provide additional information to the member for Nedlands, who asked about cyber attacks on the Department of the Premier and Cabinet in questions without notice 694 and 695. I confirm the number of attempted attacks as referred to by the member. I further advise that no data was compromised. To mitigate against further attacks, the Department of the Premier and Cabinet published a sector-wide cyber alert, blocked all outbound DPC connections to the relevant fake website and performed a review to identify any accounts that may have been compromised—none were found. All DPC users that received an email from a compromised account were also contacted to inform them of the risk.
