Hon JON FORD replied:

(1)(a-g) Western Australia Police is able to confirm that 10 360 infringements issued for speeding for the period 10th to 16th March 2006.

It would require considerable time and resources to further interrogate the data in order to retrieve the specific data requested. The Commissioner of Police has advised he is not prepared to waste valuable resources by diverting them away from core policing activities.

(2)(a-g) Receiving payment of traffic infringements falls within the responsibility of the Department for Planning and Infrastructure.
