4654. Ms J. Farrer to the Minister for Police:

I refer to the Liquor enforcement team of WA police, and the 'sly grog' market in the area of the Kimberley with restrictions, and I ask:

- (a) do WA Police have an estimate of the size of the current 'sly grog' market in the Kimberley;
- (b) if yes to (a):
 - (i) what is it;
 - (ii) how did the police reach that figure; and
 - (iii) can WA police comment as to whether they believe the size is increasing or decreasing and on what basis; and
- (c) can WA Police identify which towns in the Kimberley are the source of packaged alcohol for the 'sly grog' market?

Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:

- (c) No. Packaged alcohol can be sourced from all major towns in the Kimberley.
