

WATER — 2011 REBATES AND CONCESSIONS

2659. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Minister for Water:

For each of the following months: January 2011; February 2011; March 2011; April 2011; May 2011; June 2011; July 2011; August 2011; September 2011; October 2011; November 2011; and December 2011 can the Minister advise the amounts provided in rebates or concessions in relation to each of the following:

- (a) Pension Concession card holders;
- (b) State Concession card holders;
- (c) Western Australian Seniors card holders; and
- (d) Commonwealth Seniors Health card holders?

**Aqwest**

**Water Corporation**

- (a)–(d) The Water Corporation charges are billed over the financial year period, not the calendar year. Until 1 July 2013, the Corporation could only provide yearly totals for pension and concession rebates. From 1 July 2013, a change in billing method (two monthly billing) enabled the Corporation to provide concessions and rebates details on a monthly basis. Western Australian Senior Card Holders and Commonwealth Seniors Card Holders are not eligible for a water use concession — only a service charges rebate.
