

CROWN LAND LOT 9789, ALFRED COVE

Petition

MRS L.M. O'MALLEY (Bicton) [9.02 am]: I have a petition containing 27 signatures, which has been certified by the Clerk, in the following terms —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say that:

- Crown Land Lot 9789 in Alfred Cove is publically accessible land adjacent to the Swan Estuary Marine Park.
- The priority for land-use planning and development adjacent to the river must protect and enhance the ecological health, amenity and heritage value of the Swan Canning River System for the public benefit of Western Australia.

Therefore we ask that:

- Any sale of Crown Land Lot 9789 to the City of Melville be rejected because private commercial interests would profit at the expense of publicly accessible amenity and river health.
- As a matter of urgency, the Government legislates for the retention and continuing protection of Crown Land Lot 9789 in Alfred Cove by bringing it into the conservation estate as recommended by the whole-of-Government Draft Perth & Peel Green Growth Plan.
