

MINISTERS OF THE CROWN - CODE OF CONDUCT

3246. Hon Nigel Hallett to the Leader of the House representing the Premier

- (1) Is the Premier going to be introducing a new Ministerial Code of Conduct?
- (2) If 'yes' to (1), when is this scheduled to be introduced?

Hon KIM CHANCE replied:

- (1) The Ministerial Code of Conduct was adopted in 2001 to assist in ensuring the highest standards of conduct and integrity. A number of changes to the Code to enhance the capacity to deliver good government are currently under consideration, including the development of new guidelines to better define the obligations of Ministers under sections 6, 7 and 8 of the Code.
- (2) A date has not been scheduled at this time.
