## GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, RELOCATION OF OFFICES TO ROCKINGHAM

434. Mr McGOWAN to the Minister for Primary Industry; Fisheries:

I refer to Government offices, instrumentalities and agencies under the control of the Minister and ask -

- (a) which Government offices in Perth are planned for re-location;
- (b) when do the relevant leases expire in relation to these offices;
- (c) has the Government considered re-locating any of these offices into the Rockingham City centre precinct;
- (d) if not, why not;
- (e) will the Government discuss this matter with the Rockingham City Council; and
- (f) if not, why not?

# Mr HOUSE replied:

## Agriculture WA

- (a) Agriculture WA does not plan to relocate any of their Perth offices.
- (b-f) N/A.

### Fisheries WA

- (a) At present there are no plans for the relocation of any Fisheries offices.
- (b) N/A.
- (c) I am advised that Fisheries WA has undertaken some preliminary enquiries in establishing an office in Rockingham. However, such an initiative will be dependent on a review of the Metropolitan regional operations and confirmation that the establishment of a Fisheries Office in Rockingham is justified.
- (d) N/A.
- (e-f) I would be happy to have the Executive Director of Fisheries WA facilitate initial discussions with the Rockingham City Council in respect to future planning and the potential to establish an operational office in Rockingham.
