With respect to educating service providers, about their legal obligations and resourcing available resulting from the *Commonwealth Disability Discrimination Act* -

- (1) What professional development has been provided to -
 - (a) District Offices;
 - (b) School Principals; and
 - (c) teachers,

over the past 5 years?

What additional resourcing/assistance is available to schools and parents of children diagnosed with autism and ADHD?

Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

- (1)(a,b) Professional Development is provided through the Building Inclusive Schools Strategy and ongoing support from the Centre for Inclusive Schooling.
- (1)(c) Professional Development has commenced in 2005 for teachers through the Building Inclusive Classrooms Strategy. Ongoing support over the past five years has been provided from the Centre for Inclusive Schooling.
- (2) Services for students with autism are allocated \$1.22 million annually. Since 2000, the Department of Education and Training has provided resources, professional development and conferences aimed at increasing teacher knowledge of ADHD.
