# WATER CORPORATION — OVERDUE ACCOUNT INTEREST CHARGES

### 3004. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Minister for Water:

I refer to the interest charged by the Water Corporation on overdue accounts to customers, and ask:

  - (viii) 2014–2015 to date; and
- (b) what was the total interest revenue earned by the Water Corporation on overdue accounts in:
  - (i) 2007–2008;
  - (ii) 2008–2009;
  - (iii) 2009–2010;
  - (iv) 2010–2011;
  - (v) 2011–2012;
  - (vi) 2012–2013;
  - (vii) 2013–2014; and
  - (viii) 2014–2015 to date?
