

CORRECTIVE SERVICES — COMMUNITY-BASED ORDERS

1859. Hon Tjorn Sibma to the minister representing the Minister for Corrective Services:

Of the current cohort of offenders subject to Community Based Orders (CBO), what proportion of the group are subject to a CBO of the following duration:

- (a) six months;
- (b) six to twelve months;
- (c) twelve to eighteen months; and
- (d) eighteen to twenty-four months?

**Hon Stephen Dawson replied:**

The Department of Justice advise:

(a)–(d) As at midnight 26 March 2024, there were 2,313 offenders subject to a CBO. Table 1 provides those offenders by CBO duration.

Table 1: Offenders Subject to a CBO as of Midnight 26 March 2024, by Duration Group.
