

ENVIRONMENT — JARRAH FORESTS

3335. Hon Diane Evers to the Minister for Environment:

For each of the years 2017–2018, 2018–2019 and 2019–2020, what was the area of jarrah forest logged with the following silvicultural objectives:

- (a) release of regeneration (gap);
- (b) establishment of regeneration (shelterwood);
- (c) promote growth on retained trees (thinning);
- (d) single tree selection (retention in *Phytophthora* dieback areas);
- (e) selective; and
- (f) other (please specify)?

Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

Statistics for forest areas cutover to the silvicultural objectives are maintained on a calendar year basis. The area (in hectares) recorded as harvested in 2017, 2018 and 2019 respectively to each of the silvicultural objectives is;

- (a) 511, 635, 559
 - (b) 1075, 1554, 570
 - (c) 1070, 1290, 1165
 - (d) 1435, 1028, 1016
 - (e) 868, 168, 499
 - (f) Mine clearing: 978, 918, 1273
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
