176. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Housing:

I refer to the interim agreement with Fleetwood for the operation and management of Osprey Village.

- (1) On what date were discussions with Fleetwood last held and what was the outcome of those discussions?
- (2) Was it Treasury, the State Solicitor's Office or a legal officer who reviewed the interim agreement?
- (3) If it was a legal officer, who was the officer, and where does that officer work?
- (4) If Treasury did not review the interim agreement, did Treasury separately provide approval for the department to enter into an agreement where the state may be liable for a capital payout to Fleetwood?
- (5) How many dwellings at Osprey are occupied as at today's date?

Hon COL HOLT replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The department can confirm that discussions are ongoing and are commercial-in-confidence. Disclosure may impact commercial negotiations with Fleetwood around the terms of the formal agreement.
- (2) The interim agreement was drafted by Lavan Legal on the department's instruction and reviewed by the department's legal and legislative services branch.
- (3) It was a legal officer within the department's legal and legislative services branch.
- (4) No; it is not required in accordance with the Housing Act 1980.
- (5) As at today's date, 196 dwellings are occupied at Osprey.
