

WORKSAFE WESTERN AUSTRALIA, GRANTS FOR TRAINING

781. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection

I refer the Minister to grants from WorkSafe for training and ask -

- (a) how many individuals and/or organisations received grants for WorkSafe training in the financial year ending June 2000;
- (b) what are the names of these individuals and/or organisations and the amount of each grant;
- (c) how many individuals and/or organisations received grants for WorkSafe training in the financial year ending June 2001;
- (d) what are the names of these individuals and/or organisations and the amount of each grant;
- (e) how many individuals and/or organisations received grants for WorkSafe training in the financial year ending June 2002;
- (f) what are the names of these individuals and/or organisations and the amount of each grant;
- (g) have there been any changes made to funding of individuals and/or organisations since June 2002;
- (h) how many individuals and/or organisations have or will receive grants for WorkSafe training in the financial year beginning July 2002; and
- (i) what are the names of these individuals and/or organisations and the amount of each grant?
