(1)-(4) The Western Australia Police Service advise, Mr Les Smith AM, was paid amounts of \$705 on 26/08/98 and \$3,420 on 22/02/99, as a contractor not a consultant, to assist with several senior police selections.

WAPS advise that only those payments made directly to Mr Smith can be identified from the Police Service financial management information system. Any payments made indirectly, for example via any companies or businesses associated with Mr Les Smith, cannot be verified.

A search of the current WAPS financial management information system, which was introduced in 1998, failed to locate any other payments to Mr Smith.
