## 574. Ms M.J. DAVIES to the Premier:

As the Premier is the minister responsible for setting ministerial standards, I ask —

- (1) Can the Premier outline his understanding of the details of the Attorney General's helicopter flight, including who was on the flight and whether there was a return chopper flight?
- What investigation did the Premier undertake to confirm that the total value of the Attorney General's chopper flight complied with the members of Parliament financial disclosure laws?

## Mr M. McGOWAN replied:

(1)–(2) I know what I have heard publicly—that the Attorney General allegedly attended a birthday party with a friend via a mode of transport. That is what I understand. I think the other parts of the member's question are irrelevant.
