

YELLAGONGA REGIONAL PARK, FINAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

73. Mrs C.L. Edwardes to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

I refer to the answer to question on notice No. 79 where the Minister indicated that CALM was awaiting comments from the City of Wanneroo, and ask: -

- (a) has the Final Management Plan for Yellagonga Regional Park been approved by the Conservation Commission;
- (b) if not, what is the cause of the delay; and
- (c) if so, when will it be released?

Dr J.M. EDWARDS replied:

- (a) No.
- (b) The Department of Conservation and Land Management has been negotiating future land tenure arrangements in the park with the City of Wanneroo. The future land tenure arrangements were recently agreed on at officer level and require the endorsement of the Wanneroo City Council.
- (c) It is anticipated that the plan will be released in late 2002.
