

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, TEMPORARY AND CONTRACT POSITIONS

254. Hon C L Edwardes to the Minister for Community Development; Women's Interests; Seniors and Youth; Disability Services; Culture and the Arts

For each Department or Agency under the Minister's control –

- (a) how many temporary and contract positions are there; and
- (b) what is the annual salaries and wages budget exclusive of Workers Compensation and Superannuation for the temporary and contract positions?

Ms McHALE replied:

For each of Department or Agency under the Minister's control:

Culture and the Arts

- (a) 105 as at 21 June 2001.
- (b) A total salaries and wages budget is allocated to each agency. This is not categorised by mode of employment.

Disability Services Commission

- (a) Eight temporary and contract positions currently.
- (b) There is no specific budget allocation for temporary and contract positions. Funding of these positions is included in the salary budget constructs for the Commission.

Community Development, Women's Interests, Seniors and Youth:

Family and Children's Services does not designate specific positions as temporary or contract. The department engages individuals on a temporary or contract basis against existing positions to meet changing demands for the provision of services to the community. As a result, the salary for individuals engaged in this way, is met from within the department's total salary allocation.
