

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, WRITTEN POLICY ON PAYMENT OF
MEMBERSHIPS TO CLUBS/ASSOCIATIONS

1547. Hon. C.L. Edwardes to the Deputy Premier; Treasurer; Minister for Energy

- (1) For all Government departments or agencies within the Deputy Premier's portfolio, will the Deputy Premier advise if there is a written policy in respect of payments of memberships to a club/association for a member of staff since the February State Election of 2001?
- (2) If so, will the Deputy Premier table the policy?
