

CHILDREN WITH A DISABILITY — CHILDHOOD INTERVENTION SERVICES

371. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Disability Services:

I refer to early childhood intervention services for children with a disability.

- (1) What was the total government funding allocated to these services through the Disability Services Commission for the following years —
 - (a) 2004-05;
 - (b) 2005-06;
 - (c) 2006-07; and
 - (d) 2007-08?
- (2) Which non-government organisations received government funding for the provision of these services and, for each organisation, how many places are currently funded and how much funding do they receive?

Hon SALLY TALBOT replied:

I thank Hon Donna Faragher for some notice of this question. On behalf of the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Disability Services, I advise the honourable member that the answer provided by the minister is in terms that do not strictly constitute a table.
