

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, LEVEL 9 POSITIONS

229. Hon C L Edwardes to the Minister for Labour Relations; Consumer Affairs; Employment and Training

As at 1 May 2001, for departments, agencies and statutory authorities under the control of the Minister, that are not Senior Executive Service Organisations (as defined by the Public Sector Management Act 1994), will the Minister advise -

- (a) the number of positions that have remuneration greater or equal to a Level 9 Public Servant but who is not a Chief Executive Officer, medical officer or legal officer;
- (b) for each of these positions -
 - (i) the title of the position;
 - (ii) the name of the department, agency or statutory authority;
 - (iii) the annual salary for the position;
 - (iv) the classification of the position;
 - (v) the name of the substantive occupant of the position;
 - (vi) whether the position is full-time or part-time;
 - (vii) the date the substantive occupant was appointed to the position;
 - (viii) the start and finish date of the substantive occupant's contract for the position;
 - (ix) the classification of the substantive occupant;
 - (x) does the substantive occupant have right of return to the public sector; and
 - (xi) where the position is vacant, the name of the officer acting in that position?
