I receive hundreds and hundreds of briefing notes every month. I am sorry that I did not remember the exact details of a briefing note from a year ago, member for Bassendean. I provided the member with the best information I had —

Mr J.M. FRANCIS: I provided the information on the basis that it was my understanding of what the situation was. If the member wants to go into detailed questions about reports that were released a year ago or an incident that was over 12 months ago, on a scale of issues confronting emergency services right now, I do not think this is a really big one.

Mr D.J. Kelly interjected.

The SPEAKER: Member for Bassendean, I call you to order for the first time.

Mr D.J. Kelly: The first responders almost lost their lives, idiot.
