

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES — MANDURAH AND PEEL REGION

**1268. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Mental Health:**

I refer to the minister's comments in the *Mandurah Mail* on 3 November, which state —

the services which receive state government funding in Mandurah are the most appropriate to the identified needs in the region and represent the best value for taxpayers' dollars ...

- (1) Which services in Mandurah and the Peel region receive state government funding to help teenagers at risk of suicide; and where is each service located?
- (2) Who are the providers and how are these services accessed?
- (3) How many of the services in (1) operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week?

**Hon NICK GOIRAN replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

(1)–(2) I table the attached information.

- (3) The Mental Health Commission provides funding to four service providers that provide 24-hour, seven-day-a-week support to teenagers.
