932. Hon TJORN SIBMA to the Minister for Regional Development:

I ask this question without notice because the Leader of the House could not answer questions I submitted to the Premier earlier today. I refer to an answer provided to question on notice 429, which revealed that 51 public servants employed within the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety are subject to management plans by virtue of them owning shares in resources companies and/or mining or petroleum equipment and services companies.

- (1) With whom are these management plans made?
- (2) Are these management plans audited?
